When will the close reading activity occur in the unit? Week Two During Text Talk Time with teacher and reformer group.

**Text Excerpt**

“Always remember, all people are created equal.”

“Every adult should be allowed to vote.”

Susan became famous, but the more famous she got, the more some people made fun of her. They laughed at her and called her names. They worked hard to keep her quiet.

**Text-Dependent Questions**

To build confidence I will ask:

Who is the book about?

What made her famous?

FIRST EXCERPT

What does it mean to be created equal? What did the author say everyone deserved a chance to do?

SECOND EXCERPT

What does vote mean? What are some of the things we vote for?

THIRD EXCERPT

What were some of the things the author says Susan did that were not popular at the time and that people made fun of her for doing?

Why did people want to keep Susan quiet?

Susan died before all women could vote. Do you think she thought it was worth it?
