



🕒 The head of the wandering albatross is perfectly formed for eating and drinking at sea.

To get the water the wandering albatross needs to live, it drinks from the salty sea. If you drank only seawater, you would die from too much salt. But the wandering albatross is a tubenose. There are tubes under two openings on the bird's bill. When the albatross drinks salty water, the salt drips out this special nose.
