Propaganda Poster

Objective: Propaganda is selling something--an idea, a product, a belief--generally through powerful rhetoric and images. Using graphics and phrases, that piece of propaganda is promoting or persuading us. It will be your job to create a piece of propaganda.

Directions: Create a poster to promote or persuade us to like or dislike the person you have researched. If you believe that your person is truly a hero for their recorded acts during World War II, then present them on a poster that convinces your audience of his/her courageous feats of daring. However, if you feel that they were not really working for the betterment of the allies, then use your poster to convince your audience that this person should not be considered a hero.

Your Poster Needs:

1. A clear promotion or element of persuasive propaganda
2. Color, graphics, and/or artwork
3. A phrase to pull in the reader, whether it's one word or a slogan.
