



SAT School Day Questions

Will only staff members that are present in the testing room have to sign the Test Security Agreement form?

Any staff member that is taking part in the test day in any capacity must fill out the Test Security Agreement, i.e., Hall Monitor, Room Proctor, Associate Supervisors, etc. Staff members not directly involved in the administration do not need to fill out the form.

Can the test center supervisor administer the SAT alone?

Yes, if the size of the testing room calls for only one staff person to monitor testing. However, it's strongly recommended that one additional person be properly trained as a Room Proctor so they can assist during breaks, particularly if a student needs an unscheduled break.

On average how long does it typically take a student to register online?

The time needed to register online depends on the computer proficiency of the student and the number of optional demographic questions the student chooses to answer. It could take only 15 to 20 minutes, or up to 45 minutes.

Can we use a staff member if they have a relative testing in a different school?

No. A staff member cannot proctor the SAT School Day test if a member of their household or immediate family is taking an SAT Program test at any test center on the same test date. The options are for the staff to not participate in the testing administration or for the student to register for the SAT on a national SAT test administration date.

Are homeschooled or private school students allowed to register for School Day testing?

Because the funding for the Idaho SAT School Day is appropriated by the legislature through the public education appropriations, home school and private school students cannot participate with the SAT School Day administration at a local high school. Students wishing to test will have to register for a national SAT testing date. However, if the student is enrolled in at least one class at a local or online public high school, he/she can participate with the administration.

Can seniors test on school day if they pay for it?

No, there is no way for the College Board to determine self-pay students. Seniors wishing to test will have to register for a national SAT testing date.

Do individual students need to register?

Students will have the option to register themselves or you can schedule registration at school, before or after school, or during lunch. Students that do not have an email address and are not allowed to have an email will have the option of registering using a mailed in paper form.

Will testing start around the state at the same time?

The test administration should begin at approximately the same time as classes would normally begin. To allow for adequate check-in time, the check-in procedures may need to start 45-90 minutes prior to the scheduled test start time. Due to the two different time zones, testing may start an hour or so apart in some cases.

If schools need to administer a make-up, will they be able to use the same testing materials provided to them during the test date?

Schools cannot re-use any test materials. Once SAT School Day testing is over, any leftover materials need to be returned in accordance with the instructions provided. New materials will be shipped for the make-up administration.
