**OPTIONAL:** Students who take the ACCUPLACER Diagnostic can choose to take the SAT or ACCUPLACER Placement their senior year.

**ACCUPLACER  
Diagnostic**  
Assessment is for diagnostic use only:

- No cut scores
- Assessment should be used to identifying course placement for the subsequent school year.
- Assessment should be used to determine intervention strategies in the areas student is struggling in

Spring Window –  
March through Early May

**ACCUPLACER  
Placement**  
Meets IDAPA CEE/Placement Junior Requirement, but should only be taken senior year.

- Optional for Idaho public school seniors who took the Diagnostic test in their junior year.
- Assists to determine if a student is prepared to enter subject area college level courses, or if that student will need remediation.
- Current cut scores would require a student to score an almost perfect score.
