Student Growth

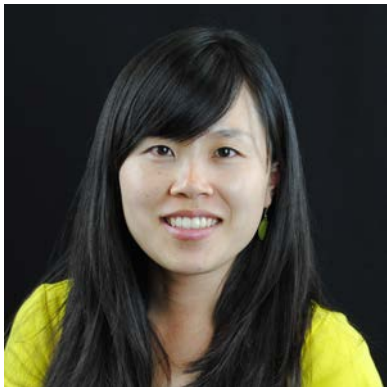


- Growth to proficiency using a trajectory model

Science Update



- Last year's assessment is the same assessment for grades 5, 7 and EOC Biology and Chemistry
- No assessment changes until the TEMPORARY Idaho Science Content Standards are Approved by the Legislature
- “3-D” Science practice items will be available December 1

WIDA: ACCESS 2.0



- Test materials ordering in ams: 10/30-11/28
- Load pre-ID file into ams: 10/30-11/28
- WATCH VIDEO: <https://www.wida.us/Assessment/AMS.aspx>
- Pre-id file is route to add students in wida ams
- Materials ordering is separate.
- Larger districts with 3 or more elem. schools, have option of having pre-id file serve as initial materials order. Many warnings if you opt for this but is possible. PLEASE EMAIL ME IF INTERESTED AND HAVE NOT yet received an email from me.



Paper Materials Ordering and Shipping

- WIDA will be distributing more paper materials than in past – 15% MORE.
- WIDA RECOMMENDS ORDERING FOR YOUR CURRENT NEEDS ONLY.
- Hope to reduce additional materials ordering
- ALT ACCESS is a separate order field
- No need to calculate writing booklets for grades 1-3 if testing online; automatic calculation by DRC.
