August 21 - September 29, 2017	<b>Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI), Fall</b>	Fall Reporting via ISEE, October 16, 2017.
October 11, 2017	PSAT	State-wide Optional Sophomore Administration (state-funded).
January 1 – March 31, 2018	<b>ISAT Alternate Science (IPASS Portfolio Submission)</b>	Required for Grades 5, 7, and 10. IPASS Closing March 31, 2018 at midnight (12:00 am MST).
January 29 – March 9, 2018	NAEP	NAEP will administer social studies, science, mathematics and reading assessments to students in grades 4, 8 and 12.
February 26 – May 18, 2018	<b>End-of-Course Science (Biology and Chemistry)</b>	The EOC is a component of the Comprehensive Assessment Program. The High School End of Course assessments in Biology or Chemistry are administered in the spring to students in grades 10–12.
January 29 – March 9, 2018	<b>WIDA – ACCESS 2.0 Idaho’s English Language Proficiency Assessment</b>	ACCESS 2.0 for ELs (Assessing Comprehension and Communication in English State-to-State for English Language Learners) is the English language proficiency assessment given to Kindergarten through 12th graders who have been identified as English Learners (ELs).
March 5—May 25, 2018	ICILS	International assessment of computer and information literacy given to a small sample of students in Grade 8.
March 19 – May 18, 2018	<b>ISAT- ELA &amp; Math</b>	Required for Grades 3-8 and 10 (Grades 9 & 11 - optional).

March 19– May 18, 2018	ISAT Alternate Assessment ELA & Math by NCSC	Required for Grades 3-8 and 11 for eligible students.
April 16 – May 18, 2018 <b>(NEW DATE)</b>	Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI), Spring	Spring Reporting via ISEE, closes June 29, 2018. Scores can be uploaded in the May or June ISEE upload.
April 10, 2018 April 24, 2018	SAT— School Day Administration SAT (Make-up)	11th Grade, state funded college entrance exam. Make-up date intended for students registered for, but not in attendance on school day administration.
District/School Determination	Civics	Students must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the fundamentals of United States history and the principles and form of United States government. Districts provide their own assessment.  Law requires students to take the 100 questions from the United States Citizenship and Immigrations Services Naturalization Test. A school district or public charter school shall document on the pupil’s transcript that the pupil has passed with a passing threshold.
No Testing School Year 2017-2018	PIRLS	International comparative study of the reading literacy of young students. PIRLS studies the reading achievement and reading behaviors and attitudes of 4th grade students in the U.S. and participating countries.
No Testing School Year 2017-2018	PISA	International assessment that measures 15-year-old students’ reading, mathematics and science literacy every three years.

<b>Assessment Monitoring</b>	Provide districts an opportunity to self-evaluate and improve assessment programs – required under federal and state law (ESSA)
<b>EOC</b>	End of Course Assessment (Biology or Chemistry) all students are required to participate once during high school years
<b>ICILS</b>	International Computer and Information Literacy Study
<b>ISAT Alternate Assessment ELA and Math by NCSC</b>	Idaho National Center and State Collaborative Alternate Assessment Consortium - for eligible students
<b>IRI</b>	Idaho Reading Indicator -
<b>ISAT- Alternate Science</b>	Idaho Standards Achievement Tests Alternate Assessment (ePortfolio version for students that meet the criteria for participation on the alternate assessment)

<b>PIRLS</b>	Progress in International Reading Literacy Study <i>No testing during School Year 2017-2018</i>

<b>PSAT</b>	Comprehensive assessment that provides students with an array of data and resources and prepares students for SAT - 10th grade option
<b>SAT</b>	College Entrance Exam – 11th grade requirement
