

**Lower than those in 28 states/jurisdictions**


**Higher than those in 11 states/jurisdictions**



## Grade 4 Reading Gap






## Grade 4 Math Achievement Levels





## Grade 8 Reading Overall




In 2013, the average score in Idaho (270) was

**Not significantly different from those in 18 states/jurisdiction**


## Grade 4 Reading Achievement Levels



## Grade 8 Math Overall




In 2013, the average score in Idaho (286) was

**Not significantly different from those in 13 states/jurisdictions**


## Grade 8 Math Achievement Levels


