

2015 Legislative Update

A summary of rule changes are attached to this email in the *New Legislation 2015 Session* document. There is additional information on the State Department of Education's website that was presented at the Post-Legislative Tour. The link is as follows: http://www.sde.idaho.gov/site/postLeg/.

For teacher certification rules, all changes were originally recommended by the Professional Standards Commission (PSC) as part of their review of professional standards for teachers, as stated in 33-1258, Idaho Code.

Each rule was submitted to the Board of Education for approval as a proposed or temporary rule, made available for public comment, resubmitted for Board approval as a pending rule, and finally approved by the 2015 Legislature.

Teacher Preparation Standards, Certification, Endorsement, and Praxis exam changes will be updated on the SDE/PSC website by August 1, 2015.

Idaho Administrative Code

Changes were made in the following sections of IDAPA 08.02.02:

- 08.02.02.027.01, Pupil Personnel Services Certificate, Counselor Endorsement
- 08.02.02.028, Exceptional Child Certificate, Generalist Endorsement (K-12), Early Childhood Special Education Endorsement (Pre-K-3), Hearing Impairment Endorsement (K-12), and Visual Impairment Endorsement
