Background

The Professional Standards Commission received an allegation of unethical conduct concerning Michael J. Sermon, from which an inquiry was launched. Before the Executive Committee's review of the case and a finding of probable cause, Mr. Sermon voluntarily surrendered his certificate. The Commission enters these findings under Idaho Code § 33-1208(3).

GENERAL AVERMENTS

1. The Professional Standards Commission (Commission) regulates teacher certification in Idaho.

- 2. Mr. Sermon held the following certificates and endorsements issued under the authority of the Idaho State Board of Education:
 - a. Degree Based Career Technical with CTE-Business Technology Education (6-12) endorsement, effective August 14, 2018, through August 27, 2019, when his surrendered certificate was invalidated.
 - b. Standard Instructional Certificate with Business Technology Education (6-12) endorsement, effective August 14, 2018, through August 27, 2019, when his surrendered certificate was invalidated.
 - 3. Mr. Sermon was employed by the Buhl Joint School District ("District") for the

2018-2019 school year as a teacher at Buhl High School.

4. On February 22, 2019, a Criminal Complaint was filed against Mr. Sermon in the

Fifth Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Twin Falls, in Case No. CR42-

19-1875. A copy of the criminal complaint is attached as Exhibit A.

FINDINGS – 1 Michael J. Sermon 5. The Criminal Complaint alleged one count of Sexual Battery, a misdemeanor under Idaho Code § 18-924.

6. On or about December 6, 2018, Mr. Sermon was alleged to have willfully made physical contact with the intimate parts, and without the consent, of K.S., a minor female student at Buhl High School, with the intent of arousing, appealing to, or gratifying the lust, passion and/or sexual desires of Mr. Sermon and or K.S.

7. On July 16, 2019, based upon a voluntarily plea of guilty, judgment was entered against Mr. Sermon in the aforesaid criminal matter for one count of misdemeanor battery, a violation of Idaho Code § 18-903. A copy of the Judgment is attached as Exhibit B.

8. On August 21, 2019, Mr. Sermon voluntarily surrendered his educator credentials "to avoid being subject to further disciplinary action and oversight and to resolve this matter." A copy of the Surrender is attached as Exhibit C.

9. Based upon the above findings, the Commission finds that Mr. Sermon willfully violated Idaho Code, Section 33-1208(1)(j), and Principles II and X of the Code of Ethics for Idaho Professional Educators.

These findings are effective on the day signed. These findings and the voluntary surrender form submitted by Mr. Sermon, which will be attached to this Order, are public records, and may be made available on the State Department of Education or Commission website.



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

RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

Application for renewal of an Idaho Education Credential must be made using forms supplied by the Idaho State Department of Education. Application may be made between January 1 and August 31 of the renewal year. For renewal information and forms, please see: www.sde.idaho.gov/cert-psc/cert/apply/renewal.html

To renew a 5-year credential, all certificated personnel must complete at least 6 semester (or 9 quarter) credit hours during the validity period of the credential, which is between September 1 of the year the credential is issued and August 31 of the year it expires.

At least 3 semester credit hours must be taken for college or university credit. Non-university clock hours may be used for up to 3 of the 6 credits required for renewal. Fifteen (15) clock hours are equivalent to one renewal credit, if verified by an Idaho school district official on a signed B-7 Verification of Completion of Equivalent Inservice form. If you have been issued a three-year Idaho Interim Certificate, you will need to meet the requirements listed on the evaluation that was sent with your credential to qualify for a five-year credential. Those requirements are also listed in the deficiency area at the bottom of the credential.

NOTE: Action of the State Board of Education and/or the Idaho Legislature may result in additional coursework and/or testing being required to renew an Idaho Education Credential. Please contact the Certification Office or go to our website (www.sde.idaho.gov/cert-psc/cert/apply/renewal.html) for details on any new renewal requirements.
