

COLLEGE AND CAREER ART CONTEST: 2ND ANNUAL ART CONTEST OPEN TO PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS GRADES 7-12

(BOISE) -- Please join the Idaho State Department of Education in notifying all students in grades 7-12 that the 2nd annual **College and Career Art Contest** begins September 12, 2016.

The 2016 winner, Andrew Ward of Fruitland High School is displayed to the right as an example of college and/or career goals, and for clarification on the expectations of this art contest.

Superintendent Sherri Ybarra is asking students across the state to be part of the contest, capturing their personal vision of what it means to be college or career ready including persistence, determination, and grit.



Artwork should visualize two key questions:

1. What are your college and/or career goals?
2. What does perseverance look like, and how does it contribute to your success?

The following lists criteria and considerations for the **College and Career Art Contest**:

1. The art contest is open to all public school students in grades 7-12.
2. Artwork should be submitted in an 8.5" x 11" portrait format.
3. Artwork must be properly labeled with the following:
 - Name of student, Grade of student, District and school which student attends, Name of teacher
4. Students may use any medium they choose. (i.e. paint, pencil, digital, etc.)
5. Students must be advised that entry into this contest constitutes, 1) a waiver of all copyrights of their entries, and 2) department permission to republish entries without compensation.
6. Artwork will not be returned.
7. The winning entry will be displayed on a future Idaho State Department of Education publication, and also displayed at www.sde.idaho.gov.
8. **Submissions must be postmarked by December 1, 2016** and the winner will be notified on December 15, 2016. Artwork must be mailed to:
