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# What data do we collect?

- The SDE collects this information about students in Special Education:
  - Entry date
  - Entry reason
  - Program status
  - Progress
  - Placement
  - Disciplinary action
  - Exit date
  - Exit reason



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# Data Due Dates

- Child Count, **First Friday in November**
  - Finalized verification, February 1, 2018
- End of Year ISEE upload June 15, 2018
  - Discipline
  - Child Find (60 day)
  - Early Childhood Transition
  - Exit
- Early Childhood Outcome, June 30, 2018

  - Discipline



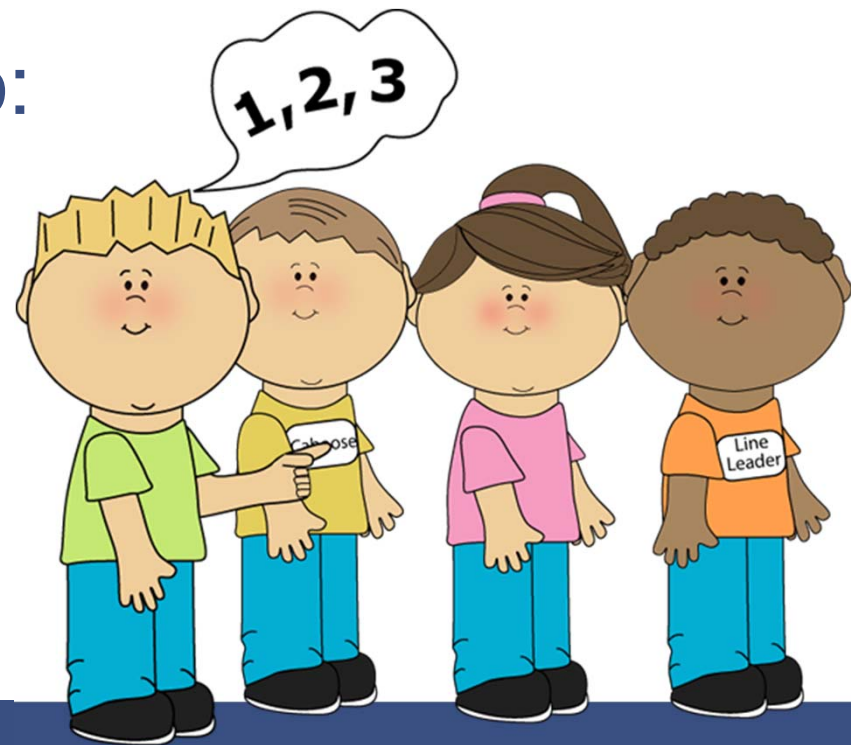
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# Child Count

- A snapshot of the number of students actively enrolled with a current eligibility and IEP on the first Friday in November.
- Things to pay attention to:
  - Educational environment
  - Exceptionality
  - Exit
  - Minutes per week  
(Preschool)



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# Changes to Exit

- Aligning codes for District exit and Special Education Program exit
  - Met Regular Graduation Requirements
  - Met Adapted Requirements
  - Removed Certificate of Completion/Attendance
