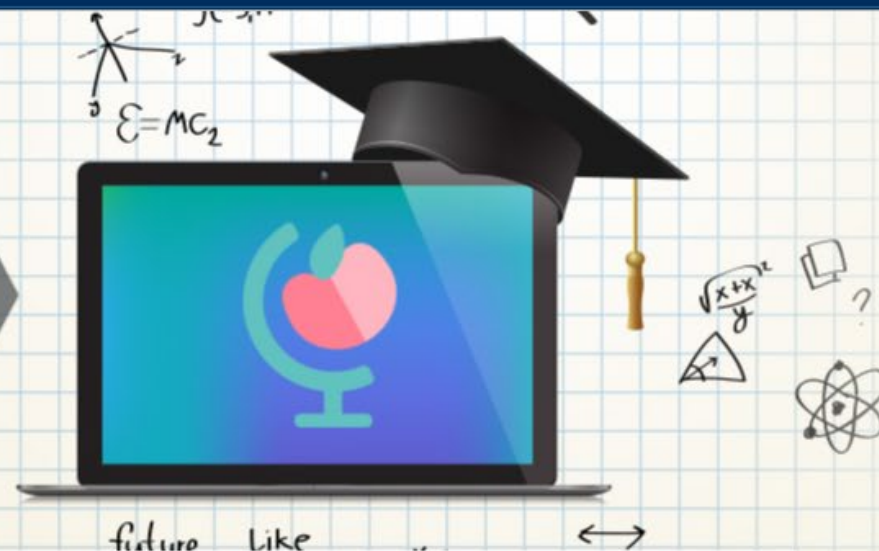

# S 1238 - Mastery/Innovation



- Self-directed Learner Designation (IC 33-512D)
  - Demonstrates mastery of content
  - Teacher designates
  - Demonstrates mastery of math facts
  - Demonstrates informed choices for next steps
- Districts or Charters may adopt policy for processes
- Right to flexible learning
- Meet criteria
- Reported full day attendance
- Each district or charter must report number of self-directed learners
- Student Driven Learning (IC 33-1632, IDAPA 08.02.03.105b)
  - Mastery-based/Innovation Education
  - Innovate 2 Elevate
