Topic: Supplement/not Supplant Federal Title I Funds with State Literacy Intervention Funds.

Q.1: My school has a schoolwide Title I-A program. We will receive literacy intervention funds. How can I ensure that my Title I-A funds are supplementing my state and local funds which include the literacy intervention funds?

A.1: In a schoolwide program, the LEA only needs to ensure that Title I funds are **not** used to reduce a school's state or local funds.

Q.2: My school has a targeted assistance Title I-A program. We will receive literacy intervention funds. How can I ensure that my Title I-A funds are supplementing my state and local funds which include the literacy intervention funds?

A.2: In a targeted assistance program, the LEA must ensure that both Title I-A funds and activities are supplemental to the school's state and local funds and activities.

Example 1: Title I funds are used to provide reading intervention support to the students on the targeted rank order list. The state's literacy intervention funds may be used to supplement additional services for these students.

Example 2: Title I funds are used to provide math intervention services to the students on the targeted rank order list. The state's literacy intervention funds may be used to provide these same students reading/literacy support.

Example 3: Literacy intervention funds are used to provide support to all eligible students in the school (1 or 2 on the IRI). Title I funds may be used to provide *additional support* to the students on the targeted rank order list.

Example 4: Literacy intervention funds are used during the school year to provide support to all eligible students in the school (1 or 2 on the IRI). Title I funds are used to provide summer school to eligible students on the targeted rank order list.

Example 5: Title I-A funds are used during the school year to provide support to eligible students on the targeted rank order list. Literacy intervention funds are used to provide summer school to all eligible students in the school (1 or 2 on the IRI).

NON Example: Title I-A funds are used for literacy intervention services for students on the targeted rank order list, and Literacy intervention funds are used for services to non-Title I-A students. This is an example of supplanting funds in a targeted assistance school and is not allowable.

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
