School District #123 is committed to identifying and serving children and youth under the McKinney-Vento Act. Under this Act, children have the right to:

- Continue in the school of origin or the school last attended;
- Receive transportation to the school of origin or the school last attended;
- Attend and participate in school programs with children who have permanent housing;
- Immediately enroll in school without a permanent address;
- Enroll and attend classes while the school arranges for the transfer of school and immunization records or any other documents required for enrollment;
- Enroll and attend classes in the school of origin or the school last attended; even while the school and parent seek to resolve an enrollment dispute.

School District makes every effort to correctly identify and serve children and youth who qualify for support and services under McKinney-Vento. Parents, guardians, and unaccompanied youth who do not agree with a district determination have the right to initiate the dispute resolution process directly at the school level. The district local liaison is available to help with this process.

Students will be provided with all services for which they are eligible while disputes are resolved.
