GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Idaho State Department of Education is looking for a software developer who wants to contribute to the enhancement of public schools resources in Idaho. This position designs, codes, and maintains web applications developed in-house, as well as maintaining and rewriting web applications developed by external contractors.

This is a full-time, senior-level position, serving under appointment of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. At this level, incumbents are able to perform the full range of applications design, analysis, and programming functions. Incumbents should have 3+ years' experience in systems analysis and design and a proven track record.
