The adoption process is a 6 - year adoption cycle. It is recommended that local school districts plan their purchases of new curricular materials (textbooks) in the spring following the main subject adoption year of the State Adoption Schedule (noted in RED) and after effective contract date with publishing companies. This assures schools of purchasing state approved materials at contracted prices.
