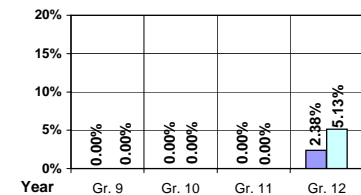
Meet AYP Goals	In 2006 we met all AYP Goals and exceeded them by wide margins. Our graduation rate improved to 100% in 2006.

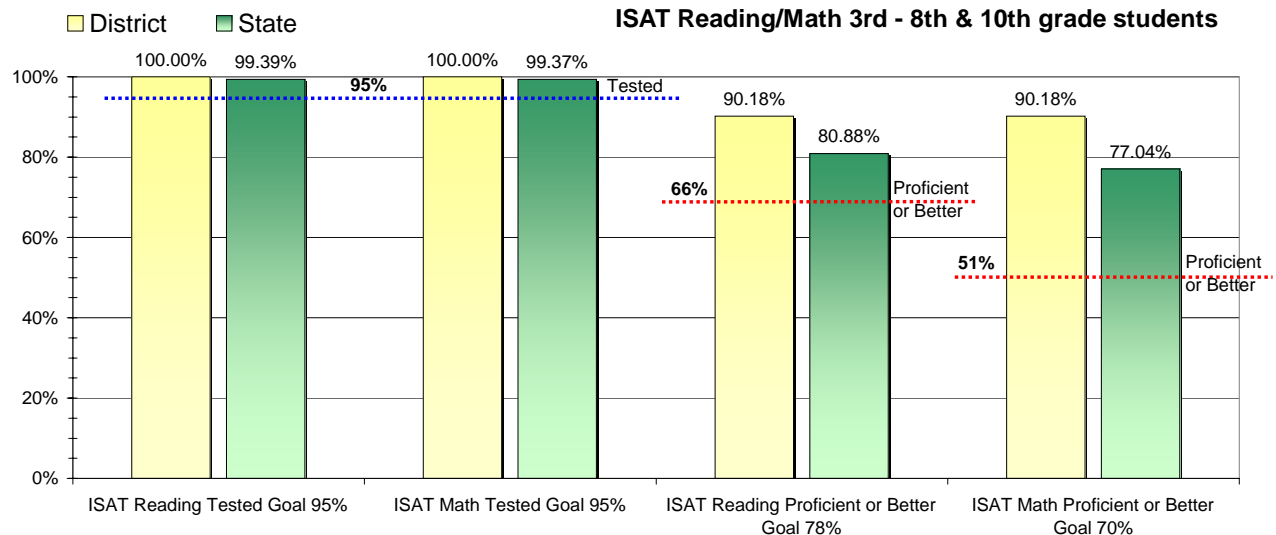
Adequate Yearly Progress and Assessment 2006-07
