## Highlights

The Genesee Joint School District continued to stay ahead of the curve in 2006-07. With the passage last fall of a \$4.85 million bond, the District will construct a five classroom and gym addition to the current school increasing capacity to handle the expected growth from the completion of the four-lane highway. The Bond was a culmination of effort taking over ten years to complete. Student achievement continues to rank at the top of school districts in Idaho due to the high quality, dedicated staff and community support. The GHS boys' basketball team was state champion.

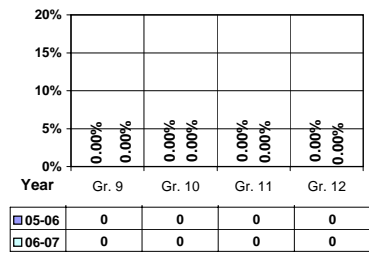

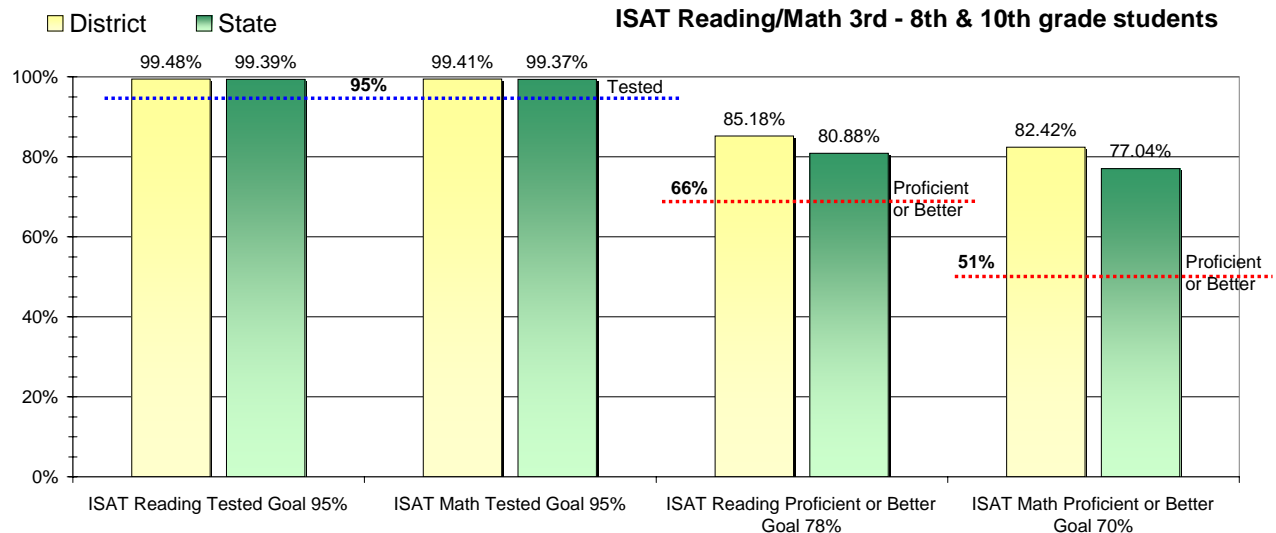
### Adequate Yearly Progress and Assessment 2006-07
