Mathematics of Personal Finance Content Standards

The Idaho State Department of Education (SDE) is a member of the Idaho Financial Literacy Coalition (IFLC). The SDE and IFLC worked cooperatively to create Mathematics of Personal Finance content standards that were approved in the Idaho Legislature this session. These content standards are the basis for a district developed personal finance course that can be used to fulfill the new high school graduation requirement in mathematics being implemented for 9th graders entering school in Fall 2009.

There are five (5) major strands in the content standards: Money Management; Savings and Investment; Education, Employment and Income; Taxation; Data Analysis and Statistics. Each strand is divided into the following goals: Understanding Effective Money Management; Making Responsible Consumer Choices; Credit and Debt; Diversified Savings and Investment Strategy; Understanding the Purposes, Roles, and Responsibility Related to Taxation. Statistics

According to the Jump\$tart Coalition "Making the Case for Financial Literacy:"

- Only 5% of adults learned money management skills in school.
- 36% of Americans acknowledge spending more than they can afford sometimes or often.
- 36% of Americans admit that at some point they have felt that their financial situation was out of control.
- More than half of teens are eager to learn more about money management, and 35% would like to learn more from their parents.
