INTRODUCTION

The 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) program is authorized under Title IV, Part B, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended by Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015.

The Idaho State Department of Education (SDE) awards funds to eligible entities on a competitive basis through a rigorous peer-review (ESSA, Sec. 4203(a)(4)). The SDE gives priority to applications that are submitted jointly by not less than one (1) local educational agency receiving funds under Title I, Part A, and another eligible entity.

However, in the case of an application where there is no such partnership available within the community, then the applicant may submit a *Partnership Waiver Form* (ESSA, Sec. 4201(b)(3)). All Partnership Waiver Forms must be submitted to the SDE before any approval is made. Applicants must demonstrate evidence of exhausting all available organizations and non-profit organizations within a reasonable geographic proximity.
