What: Math Leadership Academy 3-Credit Course Who: School Administrators and Instructional Coaches

When: First cohort begin January; next cohort begins August 2027

Where: Hybrid (In-person, Online, On-site)

Course Overview: The Math Leadership Academy is for school leaders who aspire to enhance mathematics instruction in their schools through effective supervision and evaluation. This course provides both theoretical and practical insights into mathematics content, pedagogy, and instructional leadership while aligning with Idaho's educational standards and Idaho's Teacher Evaluation Framework (Danielson). This course meets recertification requirements under Idaho Code §33-1204 and IDAPA 08.02.02.120 and is approved by the Office of the Idaho State Board of Education.

Key Learning Outcomes:

- Develop expertise in the Idaho Framework for Mathematics Instruction and Idaho's Teacher Evaluation Framework (Danielson).
- Gain skills in instructional supervision and evaluation knowledge specific to improving mathematics teaching and student learning.
- Understand best practices for assessing and providing feedback to mathematics educators.

Course Modules:

- 1. Mathematics Learning & Evaluation
- 2. Effective Mathematics Teaching
- 3. Mathematics Instructional Supervision & Feedback

Course Format:

- Three modules spanning one calendar year required for recertification
- One in-person meeting per module
- Four online sessions (synchronous/asynchronous)
- On-site RMS supported administrative walkthroughs
