Steps:

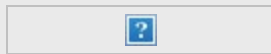
1. Sign in to the [test ordering site](#).
2. Review returned answer sheet data and make misgrid adjustments, if needed, in the "School Info" section.
3. Review the top table, which displays the total number of fee waiver benefits your school can use.
4. Identify students who are [eligible for fee waiver benefits](#). (Tip: You can filter and sort data.)

Please note: Schools will no longer see their amount due on the test ordering site. We'll send your school your January PSAT/NMSQT invoice in the mail by March 30, 2021.
