You can forward this email to your test day support staff, including proctors and SSD coordinators who may assist accommodated students, and encourage them to complete the training as well.

### Tips and Suggestions

- You'll need your school's AI code to access the training. To access your code, use the [K-12 School Code Search](#) tool to look up your institution by school name or zip code.
- Use a College Board-supported browser: Internet Explorer, Edge, Firefox, Google Chrome, or Safari. If you have any problem accessing the online learning portal, try clearing your browser's cache or temporary internet files.

- If you're a test coordinator supporting multiple tests, such as the SAT and PSAT-related assessments, you'll need to request those training courses separately. Log out and log back in using your College Board account and select **View All Available Courses** to request additional courses.
