



Dear Colleague,

You can now order test materials for fall 2021 SAT® Suite of Assessments—SAT School Day, PSAT/NMSQT, and PSAT 8/9—in the [test ordering site](#). This fall, the SDE will pay for public school 10<sup>th</sup> grade students to participate in the PSAT/NMSQT. The primary test date for the fall PSAT/ NMSQT is October 13, 2021, and the alternate test day is October 26, 2021.

Please note:

- Fall PSAT/NMSQT: Place orders in the test ordering site (TOS) for the state-provided PSAT/NMSQT or any other assessment your school plans on administering this fall. Administering any other assessment in the fall is optional. Your district or school will be responsible for paying the invoices for assessments that you choose to provide to your students outside of PSAT/NMSQT for 10th graders. Additional information about state SAT testing in Spring 2022 will be provided by SDE this fall.
- Spring SAT: DO NOT place orders in TOS for the state-provided SAT. You will need to manage and place orders for spring 2022 via bulk registration at a later date. Do not place orders for weekend administrations.

### How to Order

- 2 Sign in with the same username and password you used to order last year.

If you're a first-time user, [set up a College Board account](#). Then log in, select the yellow profile icon next to your name at the top of the page, and select **My Dashboard**. Under **Add Additional Tools and Services** select **Get Access** next to Test Ordering. There, enter your school and access code in the designated fields and click **Add**.

#### **New Ordering Enhancements**

Based on educator feedback, we made the following improvements to the ordering experience:

- **Enhanced ordering dashboard**— Ordering deadlines for making updates to a placed order, and information about invoicing are now included;
- **Simplified test ordering**- You are no longer required to order tests by grade or request PSAT/NMSQT fee waivers or SAT School Day fee reduction benefits when placing an order and;
- **Easier accommodations**- Ordering accommodated materials for PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 10 assessments is just like SAT School Day - easier and more personalized.
- **Simplified communications**- You will no longer receive emails confirming your order or shipment updates. All updates can be found directly in the test ordering site.

#### **Fall 2021 Test Dates**

**PSAT/NMSQT:** Students can take the PSAT/NMSQT in sophomore or junior year. However, the SDE will only cover the fall PSAT/NMSQT administration cost for public school sophomores. Those who take it in their junior year may meet requirements to enter the National Merit® Scholarship Program, an academic competition for recognition and scholarships. [Learn more.](#)

Primary: Wednesday, October 13, 2021

Saturday: October 16, 2021

Alternate: Tuesday, October 26, 2021

Schools that want to keep test books and review questions, answers, and answer explanations after test day should choose the October 13 or October 26 PSAT/NMSQT test date.
