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# Information for SSD Coordinators – SAT School Day Spring 2022

To: SSD Coordinators

CC: Test Coordinators, District Assessment Coordinators

We would like to provide you with some introductory information to help you prepare for this year's activities as the Students for Disabilities (SSD) coordinator for the Idaho-provided SAT School Day administration.

## The College Board Accommodations and Support Handbook

The <u>College Board Accommodations and Support Handbook</u> is available. The handbook provides helpful information for each of the different types of accommodations and how to use <u>SSD Online</u> to assist in organizing high-level tasks. The handbook also includes accommodations and supports information for all College Board assessments.

#### **SSD Coordinator Responsibilities**

The SSD Coordinator is responsible for:

- Being the school's liaison with the College Board's Services for Students with Disabilities office.
- Using <u>SSD Online</u> to submit accommodation requests on behalf of students.
- Accessing and printing the Nonstandard Administration Report (NAR) and assisting
  the test coordinator in determining rooms and staff required for administering the test
  with accommodations. The NAR is available approximately four weeks prior to test
  day.
- Partnering with the test coordinator to reconcile accommodated testing materials and administer the SAT to students who are testing with accommodations.

Schools may have more than one SSD Coordinator; however, one person needs to be identified as a primary SSD Coordinator who receives communications from College Board. For the current SSD Coordinator assignment, review the <u>CEE Peer Directory</u>.

#### **Work with your Test Coordinator**

All testing materials, including all accommodated testing materials for use are shipped to the test coordinator. The SSD coordinator can assist in inventorying and ensuring the secure storage of test materials, as needed.

- Instructions on how to access SSD Online will be emailed approximately 3-5 days after submission of the form.
