Subject: Request Accommodations for October PSAT/NMSQT

Dear SSD Coordinator:

Ordering for October PSAT/NMSQT for fall 2021 is open.

Accommodated test materials can only be ordered for students whose accommodations have been approved by the Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) office. Please submit new accommodations requests early and work with your school's PSAT/NMSQT coordinator to ensure that correct materials are ordered for your students who are testing with accommodations. For information, see collegeboard.org/ssdonline.

Please note:

- **Accommodated formats** such as braille, large print, pre-recorded audio (MP3 via streaming), assistive-technology compatible, reader's script, or large-block answer sheets will be ordered by your test coordinator.
- **The pre-recorded audio format** will be provided through an internet streaming application. If you have any students testing with pre-recorded audio, sign in to [SSD Online](https://ssdonline.collegeboard.org) and select **Go to Pre-recorded Audio (MP3 via Streaming)** to learn more. If you tested students with this accommodation last year, check your access to make sure that it still works.
- If you have students approved for the accommodation of printed copy of oral instructions, you'll be able to print a copy of instructions for them from [SSD Online](https://ssdonline.collegeboard.org). The written instructions will be available approximately one week before test day. **New:** Stand-alone scripts for students approved for Assistive Technology Compatible (ATC) formats can also be printed from SSD Online.
- **Students with accommodations that don't require specific materials** (e.g., extended time) will test with the same test book as students in the standard testing room. To determine who uses standard or accommodated materials, sign in to [SSD Online](https://ssdonline.collegeboard.org) and print a roster of students approved for accommodations. Share this roster with your school's PSAT/NMSQT coordinator.

Important Dates

Tuesday, August 24: Accommodated request deadline for October 13 PSAT/NMSQT

Wednesday, October 13: Primary SAT School Day and PSAT/NMSQT test date

Saturday, October 16: Saturday PSAT/NMSQT test date

Tuesday, October 26: Alternate PSAT/NMSQT test date

Note: For schools that participate in the spring state-provided SAT School Day and/or PSAT 10, no action is necessary to order materials for the spring 2022 . The student registration and material ordering deadlines don't apply for these state-sponsored assessments.
