SAT SCHOOL DAY RESULTS NOW AVAILABLE IN CRITICAL READING, MATH, AND WRITING SKILLS

(BOISE) – The performance summary for all SAT School Day test takers is being released, highlighting the 16,792 students who participated, Superintendent Sherri Ybarra announced today. 196 schools, throughout 105 school districts, participated in the SAT this spring which assesses students on critical reading, mathematics, and writing skills.

Results are being made available district-by-district, displaying the number of test-takers as well as results for each individual subject area. Results are also displayed within the report as a composite score, which is the sum of all subject areas.

The SAT was administered on April 15, 2015 and assesses a number of skill categories within critical reading, mathematics, and writing skills. For example, within mathematics students are assessed on number and operations, algebra and functions, as well as geometry and measures.

The SAT Senior Make-Up Day will be held on Nov. 7, 2015, and additional information will be made available to school districts at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year. The Idaho State Department of Education received feedback from 140 school districts, of which 84 districts chose to have the SAT School Day on April 12, 2016.
