Director's Update



Participation Appeals Window Opens July 15

The ISAT/IDAA Participation Rate Appeals Window was originally scheduled to open on July 12. However, due to some delays in data processing, we have had to move the window back by a few days. The participation rate appeals window will now open on **July 15** and close on **July 30**. Please see the Accountability section below for more information.

Alternate Assessment Update

The spring alternate assessments in ELA/Literacy and Mathematics were new this year and Idaho originally planned to conduct standard setting this summer. However, due to the ongoing COVID-19 disruptions, we plan to postpone that process until next summer. Idaho explored the option of sharing raw scores this year, but the U.S. Department of Education has requested that we still produce preliminary proficiency level information. We are currently working towards producing provisional scores and temporary proficiency levels that would be available for this year's alternate assessments in ELA/Literacy and Mathematics later this fall.

Reminder: Participation Rate Appeals Window

The ISAT/IDAA Participation Rate Appeals Window is scheduled to open July 15-30, 2021.

During the appeals window, you may submit an appeal in the <u>appeals app</u> for each student who did not test due to:

- documented medical condition that affected the entire testing window;
- extenuating circumstances (e.g. death in the family, house fire, etc.); and
- ISEE data errors (e.g. missing exit date, etc.)

Students who participated in the alternate assessment will be shown as non-participants in the appeals application. You do not need to submit an appeal for these students. We will be receiving the alternate assessment data in a few weeks and at that point will identify the relevant students as participants.

Reminder: COVID-19 Related Non-Participants

In addition, please submit an appeal in the <u>appeals app</u> for COVID-19 related non-participants to help us estimate the impact caused by the pandemic. Based on the comments received during the monthly webinar on **June 9, 2021**, you can now use <u>OTIS</u> to bulk upload COVID-19 related non-participants who do not meet the appeals criteria. To clarify, <u>OTIS</u> is not to replace the <u>appeals app</u> and is not for any qualifying students whose participation status needs to be appealed. More information will be provided in the future.

Spring 2021 Science ISAT Performance Data in Reporting

The spring 2021 science ISATs were independent field tests. Therefore, students will NOT receive an overall score or an Individual Student Report.

Summer 2021 Interim Testing

Summer Interim Testing Window

The summer interim testing window is June 1, 2021 to July 28, 2021. See the ISAT Portal for other Important Dates.

Interim Test Administration

Science interims can be administered in a standardized and non-standardized manner.

- Standardized = Test Delivery System (TDS)
- Non-Standardized = Assessment Viewing Application (AVA)

Both the Test Delivery System, and the Assessment Viewing Application will be available during the entire summer interim testing window which is open from **June 1, 2021 to July 28, 2021**.

The Remote Interim Testing Site is also available on the <u>ISAT Portal</u>. Students can use a conventional web browser (e.g., Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox) to access an interim assessment – remotely. Students will need their First Name (as its recorded in TIDE) and their EDUID.

Updates to Idaho Portal

Cambium Assessment Inc, (our testing vendor) is performing a significant cosmetic update to the Idaho Portal. This update will carry over many of the functionalities already in place, but will streamline and modernize the look and feel of the Idaho Portal.

The url for the Idaho Portal will remain the same (<u>https://idaho.portal.cambiumast.com/</u>), and currently we are expecting the launch of the updated Idaho Portal on **June 26, 2021**.

TIDE Rollover for SY2021-2022

For SY20-21, TIDE availability will close on July 28, 2021.

When TIDE rolls over to SY21-22, all existing user **passwords** will be cleared from the system. Users will need to request new passwords prior to logging into TIDE for the first time in SY21-22. Users should then receive an email from the Idaho Help Desk providing clear instructions on how to create a new password. Additionally, districts should review their list of users in TIDE, and add or delete any users as appropriate.

All students are deleted from TIDE during the new year rollover process. Districts should plan to upload students in August 2021 when TIDE becomes available.

Remote Administration of Summative Science ISATs for SY2021-2022

For SY20-21, added the flexibility of remote administration of the summative science ISATs.

For SY21-22, the Idaho SDE is still in the process of deciding if remote administration of the summative ISATs will be available. Spring 2021 Student Performance Data in Reporting

Student performance data from the spring 2021 ELA/L and Mathematics ISATs will appear in Reporting approximately 10 days AFTER the student has completed and submitted BOTH the CAT and the PT portions of their ISATs.

A student will still receive an Individual Student Report (ISR) that has an overall scale score. However, only groups of students will receive Claim level performance data from the Adjusted Form.

WIDA Screener for Kindergarten

The Idaho SDE will use the WIDA Screener for Kindergarten starting on **August 1, 2021** to identify provisional ELs enrolling in kindergarten and grade 1 first semester. The new kindergarten screener will replace the Kindergarten W-APT at this time. Screen-out criteria has been finalized and is outlined below:
