BACKGROUND

The Professional Standards Commission received an allegation of unethical conduct concerning Todd Jensen. Following an investigation, the Executive Committee of the Professional Standards Commission reviewed the information before it and determined that probable cause exists for initiating an administrative action against Todd Jensen's certificate. The Executive Committee has recommended the following Stipulation.

STIPULATION

- This is an agreement (Stipulation) between Todd Jensen (Mr. Jensen) and the Executive Committee (the Executive Committee) of the Professional Standards Commission (the Commission).
- 2. If Mr. Jensen wishes to agree to this Stipulation, he must sign and return this Stipulation and any attachments to the Commission by 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time) on or before **November 6, 2020**, unless he has been granted an extension.
- After Mr. Jensen and the Executive Committee agree to and sign this Stipulation, the Stipulation must be approved by the Commission, and the Commission must enter the attached consent order, before this Stipulation resolves the matter.

A. STIPULATED FACTS AND LAW

- 5. The Commission regulates teacher certification in Idaho.
- 6. Mr. Jensen holds the following certificate and endorsements issued under the authority of the Idaho State Board of Education:
 - a. Standard Secondary Certificate with Physical Education (PE) (6-12) and Health (6-12) endorsements, effective September 1, 2017, through August 31, 2022.
- Mr. Jensen was employed by the Murtaugh Joint School District teacher during 2019-2020 school year.
- 8. During this school year in a PE/weights class, Respondent took a student's phone, opened its SnapChat application, and took a picture of another student as they walked out of the locker room.
- 9. Mr. Jensen wrote "fag" on the SnapChat picture and sent it to another student in the class.
- 10. The Executive Committee determined that probable cause exists for initiating an administrative action against Mr. Jensen for violating the following laws and rule governing teacher certification:
 - a. Mr. Jensen's conduct or course of conduct willfully violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j) ("Willful violation of any professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board of education"). Specifically, Mr. Jensen violated Code of Ethics Principle II (Idaho Admin. Code r. 08.02.02.076.03) ("A professional educator

maintains a professional relationship with all students, both inside and outside the physical and virtual classroom.").

11. Mr. Jensen admits that he violated the laws and rules cited in paragraph 10 and acknowledges that there is sufficient evidence to support a finding of a violation of the laws and rule cited in paragraph 10.

B. STIPULATED DISCIPLINE

- 12. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, the following discipline will be imposed by the Commission on Mr. Jensen's certificate:
 - a. The Commission will issue a letter of reprimand.
- Any costs associated with Mr. Jensen's compliance with the terms of this
 Stipulation are his responsibility.

C. PRESENTATION OF THIS STIPULATION

- 14. Once Mr. Jensen signs this Stipulation and timely returns it to the Commission, and the Executive Committee signs this Stipulation, the Deputy Attorney General assigned to the Commission will present this Stipulation to the Commission at the Commission's next business meeting.
 - 15. The Commission may accept, reject, or modify the Stipulation.
- 16. If the Commission modifies this Stipulation, it must receive Mr. Jensen's approval on any modification before the Stipulation is effective.

D. WAIVER OF RIGHTS

- 17. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, Mr. Jensen knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waives the following rights:
 - a. the right to a hearing;
 - b. the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses;
 - c. the right to present evidence or to call witnesses, or to testify at a hearing;

- d. the right to reconsideration of the Commission's orders;
- e. the right to judicial review of the Commission's orders; and
- f. other rights accorded by the Idaho Administrative Procedure Act, and the law and rules governing teacher certification in the State of Idaho.
- 18. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, the Commission may impose discipline upon Mr. Jensen's certificate without further process.
- 19. By signing this Stipulation, Mr. Jensen agrees to waive any requirement for a hearing under Idaho Code § 33-1209(3) to be conducted within 90 days of a request for a hearing. This waiver applies to any hearing request made before the Commission ultimately rejects this Stipulation (if it does) or before Mr. Jensen ultimately rejects a modified stipulation (if Mr. Jensen does). If the Commission ultimately rejects this Stipulation or if Mr. Jensen ultimately rejects a modified stipulation, and Mr. Jensen has requested a hearing, the 90-day hearing timeframe will begin from the ultimate rejection.

F. GENERAL ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

- 20. This Stipulation contains the entire agreement between the parties, and Mr. Jensen is not relying on any other agreement or representation, whether verbal or written.
- 21. This Stipulation, if approved by the Commission, or modified and approved, resolves a contested case. If approved, the Stipulation, consent order, and any attachment are public records. And if approved, the Commission may make available through its or the State Department of Education's website a copy of the Stipulation, consent order, and any attachment, and may report any discipline to the national clearinghouse for teacher certification.
- 22. Mr. Jensen agrees that he has read this Stipulation, has had the opportunity to discuss it with legal counsel, if he so chose, and understands that by signing below, he will be agreeing to the terms of this Stipulation.

LETTER OF REPRIMAND

The Professional Standards Commission issues a formal reprimand to Todd Jensen.

The Executive Committee found that probable cause existed to warrant the filing of an administrative complaint against Mr. Jensen's certificate by the Chief Certification Officer. In lieu of filing an answer, Mr. Jensen entered into stipulated discipline. The full Professional Standards Commission considered his case and adopted the discipline recommended by the Executive Committee, which was incorporated into the stipulated discipline. Accordingly, a letter of reprimand is now issued based upon Mr. Jensen's failure to maintain a professional relationship with students through the use of inappropriate language. The Code of Ethics Principle involved in this letter of reprimand is Code of Ethics Principle II. Mr. Jensen is hereby reprimanded for such behavior. The Chief Certification Officer is directed to issue and place this letter of reprimand in Mr. Jensen's certification file.
