FINAL ORDER

The Chief Certification Officer for the State of Idaho filed an Administrative Complaint against the educator certificates issued to Jeremy R. Campbell, seeking for the Professional Standards Commission to impose discipline on Mr. Campbell's certificates. *See* Idaho Code § 33-1209. Because Mr. Campbell did not request a hearing within 30 days, and because Mr. Campbell was determined to be in default by a hearing/presiding officer, the allegations in the Administrative Complaint are treated as admitted, Idaho Code § 33-1209(3), and are incorporated by reference as findings of fact.

Based on these findings, the Professional Standards Commission concludes that Mr. Campbell willfully violated the following principles of the Code of Ethics adopted by the State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j).

The Commission specifically holds that Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct violated Idaho Code § 33-1208(2)(f) ("The professional standards commission shall permanently revoke any certificate issued or authorized under the provisions of section 33-1201, Idaho Code, and shall deny the application for issuance of a certificate of a person who pleads guilty to or is found guilty of, notwithstanding the form of the judgment or withheld judgment, any of the following felony offenses against a child: The sexual exploitation of a child, section 18-1507, Idaho Code.").

The Commission specifically holds that Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct violated Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(f) ("Conviction, finding of guilt, withheld judgment or suspended sentence, in this or any other state of a crime involving moral turpitude").

Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct willfully violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j) ("Willful violation of any professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board of education"). Specifically, Mr. Campbell violated Code of Ethics Principle II (Idaho Admin. Code r. 08.02.02.076.03) ("A professional educator maintains a professional relationship with all students, both inside and outside the physical and virtual classroom.").

Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct willfully violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j) ("Willful violation of any professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board of education"). Specifically, Mr. Campbell violated Code of Ethics Principle X (Idaho Admin. Code r. 08.02.02.076.11) ("Any conduct that seriously impairs the Certificate holder's ability to teach or perform his professional duties.").

Under Idaho Code § 33-1208, the Professional Standards Commission orders that the following discipline (as marked) be imposed on Mr. Campbell's certificates:

RECONSIDERATION AND JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is a final order of the Professional Standards Commission. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt; if not, the petition will be denied as a matter of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246. Petitions for reconsideration may be filed by mail addressed to the Professional Standards Commission, State Department of Education, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, ID 83720-0027, or hand delivered to the Commission at 650 West State Street, Second Floor, Boise, ID 83720.

Any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may seek judicial review of the orders in this case in district court. A party may do this by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court as provided in Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272. The petition must be filed within 28 days of the service date of this final order; or, if a motion for reconsideration is filed, within 28 days of the service of a decision on the motion for reconsideration or denial of the motion as a matter of law. Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the agency action. Idaho Code § 67-5274.



ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Lisa Colón Durham, Chief Certification Officer for the State of Idaho, alleges the following against Jeremy R. Campbell.

GENERAL AVERMENTS

1. The Professional Standards Commission (Commission) regulates teacher certification in Idaho.

2. The Chief Certification Officer is empowered to file an administrative complaint against the certificate of a teacher or other individual certified under the authority of the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1209.

3. Mr. Campbell holds the following certificates and endorsements issued under the authority of the Idaho State Board of Education:

- a. Administrator Certificate with School Principal (Pre-K-12) endorsement, effective February 22, 2018, through August 31, 2020;
- b. Standard Instructional Certificate with All Subjects (K-8) endorsement, effective March 31, 2015, through August 31, 2020;
- c. Provisional Authorization with English (6-12) endorsement, effective September 1, 2017, through August 31, 2018.

4. On September 28, 2018, Mr. Campbell pled guilty to the criminal charges of Count I, Sexual Exploitation of a Child by Possession of Sexually Exploitive Material, Idaho Code § 18-1507(2)(a) and Count II, Sexual Exploitation of a Child by Possession of Sexually Exploitive Material, Idaho Code § 18-1507(2)(a).

5. On October 11, 2018, Judgment and Sentence were entered against Mr. Campbell on the two aforesaid Counts in the District Court of the First Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Kootenai, Case No. CR 2018-3817. A true and correct copy of the Judgment and Sentence is attached as Exhibit A.

COUNT I

6. Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct violated Idaho Code § 33-1208(2)(f) ("The professional standards commission shall permanently revoke any certificate issued or authorized under the provisions of section 33-1201, Idaho Code, and shall deny the application for issuance of a certificate of a person who pleads guilty to or is found guilty of, notwithstanding the form of the judgment or withheld judgment, any of the following felony offenses against a child: The sexual exploitation of a child, section 18-1507, Idaho Code.").

COUNT II

7. Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct violated Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(f) ("Conviction, finding of guilt, withheld judgment or suspended sentence, in this or any other state of a crime involving moral turpitude.")(emphasis added).¹

COUNT III

8. Mr. Campbell's conduct or course of conduct willfully violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j) ("Willful violation of any professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board of education"). Specifically, Mr. Campbell violated Code of Ethics Principle II (Idaho Admin. Code r. 08.02.02.076.03) ("A professional educator maintains a professional relationship with all students, both inside and outside the physical and virtual classroom.").

COUNT IV

9. Mr. Campbell’s conduct or course of conduct willfully violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State Board of Education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1)(j) (“Willful violation of any professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board of education”). Specifically, Mr. Campbell violated Code of Ethics Principle III (Idaho Admin. Code r. 08.02.02.076.11) (“Any conduct that seriously impairs the Certificate holder’s ability to teach or perform his professional duties.”).


REQUEST FOR RELIEF

The Chief Certification Officer requests that the Commission grant the following relief, as permitted under Idaho Code §§ 33-1208 and 33-1209:

1. The Commission permanently revoke Mr. Campbell’s’ certificate.
2. That if Mr. Campbell requests a hearing, a hearing be conducted before a hearing panel, where the Chief Certification Officer and Mr. Campbell may present evidence concerning the allegations in this Administrative Complaint, to aid the hearing panel in determining whether Mr. Campbell’s certificate should be disciplined and, if so, what discipline should be imposed.
3. Any other relief that would be just under the circumstances.

On September 28, 2018, before the Honorable Rich Christensen, District Judge, you, **JEREMY ROSS CAMPBELL**, personally appeared for sentencing. Also appearing were Jed Whitaker, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Kootenai County, Idaho, and your lawyer Michael Palmer.

The Court reviewed the presentence report and having ascertained that you have had an opportunity to read the presentence report and review it with your lawyer, and you having been given the opportunity to explain, correct or deny parts of the presentence report, and having done so, and you having been given the opportunity to make a statement and having done so, and recommendations having been made by counsel for the State and by your lawyer, and there being no legal reason given why judgment and sentence should not then be pronounced, the Court did then pronounce its judgment and sentence as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THIS COURT that you, **JEREMY ROSS CAMPBELL**, having plead guilty to the criminal charge stated in Counts I and II of the Information, **COUNT I, SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD BY POSSESSION OF SEXUALLY EXPLOITIVE MATERIAL, I.C. 18-1507(2)(a)** and **COUNT II, SEXUAL**

EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD BY POSSESSION OF SEXUALLY EXPLOITIVE MATERIAL, I.C. 18-1507(2)(a), felonies, you are sentenced pursuant to Idaho Code § 19-2513 to the custody of the Idaho State Board of Corrections, to be held and incarcerated by said Board in a suitable place as follows: **COUNT I, SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD BY POSSESSION OF SEXUALLY EXPLOITIVE MATERIAL, I.C. 18-1507(2)(a)** for a **fixed term of one and one-half (1 1/2) years followed by an indeterminate term of zero (0) years for a total unified sentence not to exceed one and one-half (1 1/2) years**, **COUNT II, SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD BY POSSESSION OF SEXUALLY EXPLOITIVE MATERIAL, I.C. 18-1507(2)(a)**, for a **fixed term of one and one-half (1 1/2) years followed by an indeterminate term of zero (0) years for a total unified sentence not to exceed one and one-half (1 1/2) years**. Counts I and II are concurrent. Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Department of Corrections commencing September 28, 2018. Credit shall be given for two hundred four (204) days served from March 8, 2018 to sentencing September 28, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you pay court costs of \$545.50 within two (2) years

NOTICE OF DUTY TO REGISTER

You are hereby notified that you have pled guilty or have been found guilty of a sex offense described in I.C. 18-8303 and that by reason thereof you are required to register in writing with the Sheriff's office and give your current address in any county in the state of Idaho which you enter for the purpose of residing there either temporarily or permanently. You must register with the Sheriff's office within two (2) days after coming into a county and this requirement will continue for your lifetime, while residing in Idaho, unless ten (10) years after your discharge from probation, parole, or release from incarceration, whichever last occurs, you apply for and are granted an

exemption under I.C. 18-8310. **If you fail to register, you will be guilty of a felony and can be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed ten (10) years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000.**

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

YOU, JEREMY ROSS CAMPBELL, ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that you have a right to appeal this to the Idaho Supreme Court. Any notice of appeal must be filed within forty-two (42) days of the entry of the written order in this matter.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if you are unable to pay the costs of an appeal, you have the right to apply for leave to appeal in forma pauperis or to apply for the appointment of counsel at public expense. If you have any questions concerning your right to appeal, you should consult your present lawyer.


