Media welcome at Post-Legislative Tour stops in Boise, Twin Falls, Idaho Falls

(BOISE) – Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra will kick off her annual Post-Legislative Tour in Boise Monday, April 11, continuing to Twin Falls and Idaho Falls on Wednesday and Thursday. At each stop, the superintendent and key staff will meet with each region's district administrators to discuss what's new in Idaho education after the 2023 legislative session.

In Twin Falls, Superintendent Ybarra and House Education Committee Chairman Lance Clow, R-Twin Falls, will visit Xavier Charter School shortly before 11 a.m. Wednesday for student senior project presentations. Any media who would like to attend, please let me know – 208-863-4545 – in advance, then check in at the school office when you arrive.

Registration for the post-Legislative Tour is filled to capacity, but reporters and photographers are welcome to attend any of the sessions. The two-week state tour will continue April 19 and 20 in Coeur d'Alene and Moscow.

Each tour event is scheduled from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., with a welcome from the superintendent and updates from department heads on legislation and IDAPA rules, content standards, mastery education, certification and professional standards, federal programs, and public school finance. The Office of Group Insurance will offer information on new insurance options for Idaho educators, and State Board of Education staff will give an update on changes to Next Steps Idaho.
