Media welcome at Post-Legislative Tour stops in Coeur d'Alene, Moscow

(BOISE) – Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra’s annual Post-Legislative Tour will be in North Idaho, with stops in Coeur d’Alene and Moscow. The superintendent and key staff will meet with each region’s district administrators to discuss what’s new in Idaho education after the 2022 legislative session.

Registration for the post-Legislative Tour is filled to capacity, but reporters and photographers are welcome to attend any of the sessions.

Each meeting is scheduled from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., with a welcome from the superintendent and updates from department heads on legislation and IDAPA rules, content standards, mastery education, certification and professional standards, federal programs, and public school finance. The Office of Group Insurance will offer information on new insurance options for Idaho educators, and State Board of Education staff will give an update on changes to Next Steps Idaho.
