New dates set for South Idaho stops on SDE's Legislative Roadshow

(BOISE) – This year's State Department of Education Legislative Roadshow has been rearranged to accommodate an unusually long-running legislative session.

Stops in Boise, Twin Falls and Idaho Falls are now scheduled to close out the annual Roadshow April 29-May 1. In the works for several months, those stops had been set for the first week of April but were rescheduled because the Legislature is still in session.

School and district representatives who signed up for the South Idaho events remain registered for the new dates. In addition, the April 29 Boise Roadshow will be livestreamed so all interested Idahoans can watch.

North Idaho events are still set for Coeur d'Alene and Lewiston on April 24-25, and will now be the first stops for the 2019 Roadshow.

During the Roadshow, Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra and key staff members will discuss the legislative session and all of the latest Idaho education developments. Topics will include public school finance, new legislation and IDAPA rules, school safety, mastery-based education, ethics and technology.

Superintendents, charter school administrators, business managers and other district and school representatives have signed up to attend.
