Spots Still Available at the 2023 Idaho Family & Community Engagement Conference

(BOISE) – There are still limited seats available for educators interested in attending the 2023 Family & Community Engagement (FACE) Conference. Attendees will explore ways to increase participation and communication between families, schools and communities at their choice of two events in Boise or Coeur d’Alene. As of today, there are approximately 25 spots left at the Boise event and 20 spots left at the Coeur d’Alene event.
