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## Idaho students invited to envision future through art contest

(BOISE) – Students in grades 7 through 12 can envision their future and share that vision through the Investing in My Future Art Contest, which runs through Dec. 1.

Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra encourages students across the state to be part of the fourth annual contest, capturing their personal visions of life after high school, whether it is higher education, work or other pursuits. Winning art will be displayed in a State Department of Education publication and the SDE website.

1. Entrants must be public school students, grades 7-12.
2. Artwork should visualize the student's dreams for his or her future after high school.
  - Artwork should not include copyrighted images
3. Artwork should be submitted in an 8.5" x 11" portrait format.
  - Artwork must be labeled with name of student, grade of student, teacher name, and the district and school that the student attends
4. Students may use any medium, or combination of mediums, they choose (i.e. paint, pencil, digital, etc.).
5. Students must be advised that entry into this contest waives all copyrights of their entries, and gives the State Department of Education to republish the art without compensation.
6. Artwork will not be returned.
7. Winning entries will be displayed in a State Department of Education publication, and on the SDE website, [www.sde.idaho.gov](http://www.sde.idaho.gov).
