Additional Information Regarding Certificates and Endorsements

- A Standard Elementary Certificate with an All Subjects K/8 Endorsement allows the certificate holder to teach any subject in kindergarten through eighth (8th) grade. There are no additional requirements that need to be met. This includes, but is not limited to, science, social studies, English language arts, mathematics (etc.) in grade 6 through grade 8.
- An Exceptional Child Certificate with a Generalist K/12 Endorsement allows the certificate holder to teach any subject identified within goals and objectives on a special education student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP). There are no additional requirements that need to be met. This includes, but is not limited to, science, social studies, English language arts, and mathematics (etc.) in grade 6 through grade 12 for subjects identified within the goals and objectives on a special education student's IEP.
