Project Description

- c) Technology Education opportunities, including classroom, online and other asynchronous curriculum for public school students, that will result in students achieving broad-based information technology education and certifications and/or college credit.

a) Provide instructional software for student and staff use in whatever setting the product is being offered, such as at school or home;

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- b) Provide ongoing professional development in order to certify or otherwise qualify technology educators, to be conducted at a minimum of 6 regional locations in the State of Idaho, dates and locations to be determined by SDE;
- c) Provide continuing implementation of professional development at multiple levels, to support and enhance the access of students to technology education and certifications;
- d) Provide deployment and program support, including but not limited to, integration of technology products and services with current curriculum standards for Idaho K-12 public schools;
- e) Provide integration of programs and course offerings into existing technical programs within the schools, such as Professional Technical and Career Readiness programs;
- f) Provide for the ability of students to re-take courses not successfully passed, and any additional support such students may need towards reaching goals of achieving certification
