[Teacher document form](#): This is the blank form that the teachers receive where their scores and comments are entered. They can link items in this document under the various components if they specifically want the administrator to look at them. Sometimes they add those links to things they want us to see, otherwise we look right in their online classrooms or the Student Information system, or other docs we use like the teachers' contact trackers where they record communications. The doc shows what we'll look at and how it connects to the Danielson Framework. The rubric we use also has specific notes where we will be looking and definitions of what each indicator means.

[Danielson Rubric Crossover Rubric](#): This connects the domains and indicators with the different techniques used in the online environment. We did have the freedom to adjust the indicators for each component on our end. With that, our school leadership team (department heads, counseling, etc) said, "What does this honestly look like in our world?" and went from there. Teachers are evaluated on Domains 1-2 during the fall observation, and Domains 3-4 during the spring Observation. Idaho Virtual Academy Teacher Evaluation Documents

[Teacher Evaluation Documents](#): Our principals conduct two formal observations by observing live classes or watching recordings of live classes. They use the Danielson rubric and their training and provide feedback and appropriate proficiency levels in each component. Afterward, they meet with the teacher to review and support. In between the formal observations, they conduct informal observations, as well.
