



BROADBAND ASSISTANCE IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

If your school district or charter school has a solution to connect students and/or staff to the Internet during Idaho's stay-at-home order, such as providing parking lot WiFi or bus hotspots, the Education Opportunity Resource Committee has authorized the Broadband Program to assist with additional support for these solutions.

Note: Funds are limited, and will be awarded and disbursed on an "as needed," basis. Eligible solutions would include expanding WiFi coverage to common areas on campus such as parking lots or fields or potentially configuring WiFi on a bus that could be placed in an area of need. Funds cannot be used for individual connectivity such as installing Internet at an individual residence or procuring MiFi hotspots for checkout or lending.
