

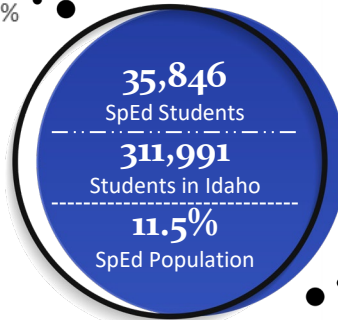
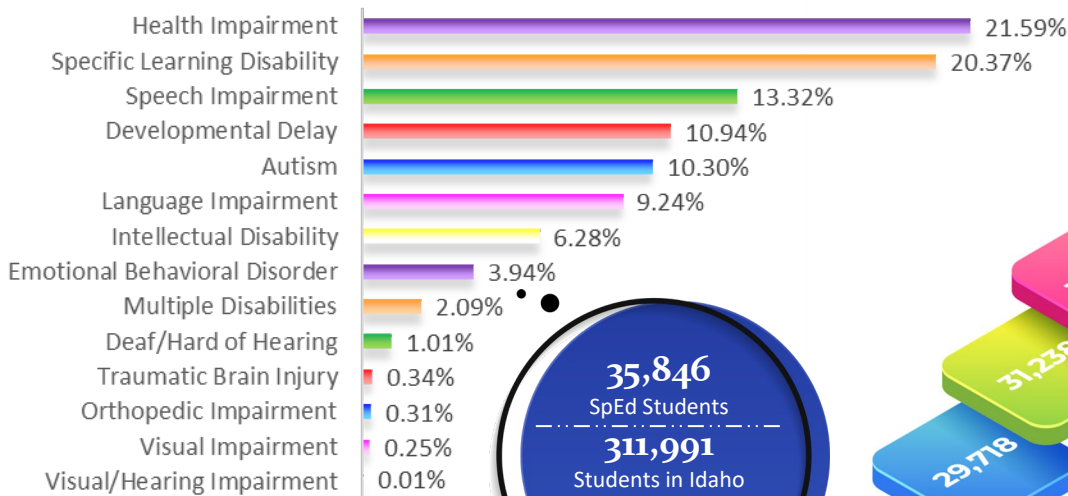

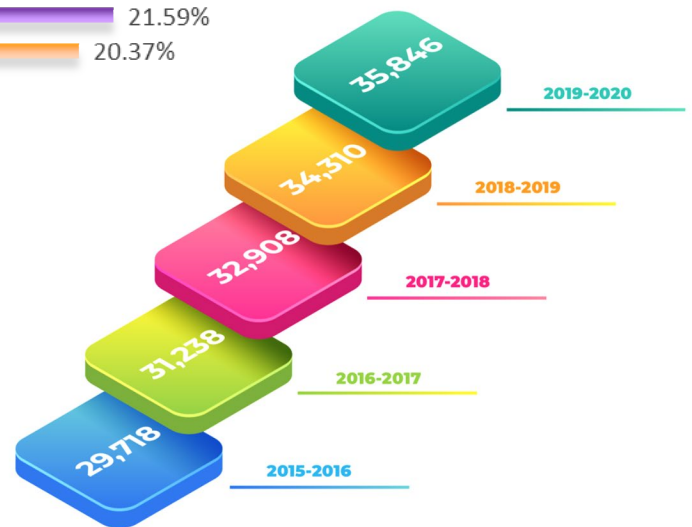
## Who We Serve

Disability Categories 2019-2020 School Year



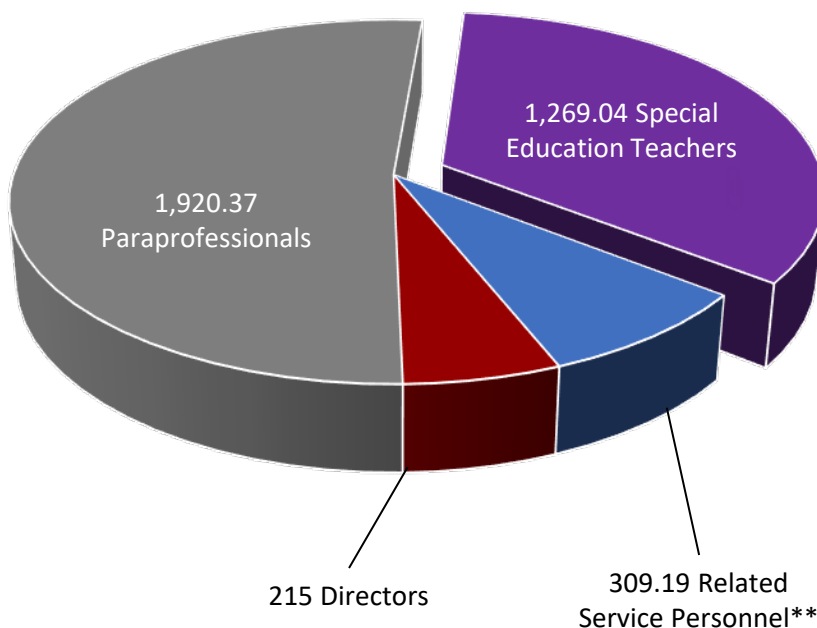
## How We've Grown

Number of Idaho Students Receiving Special Education Services



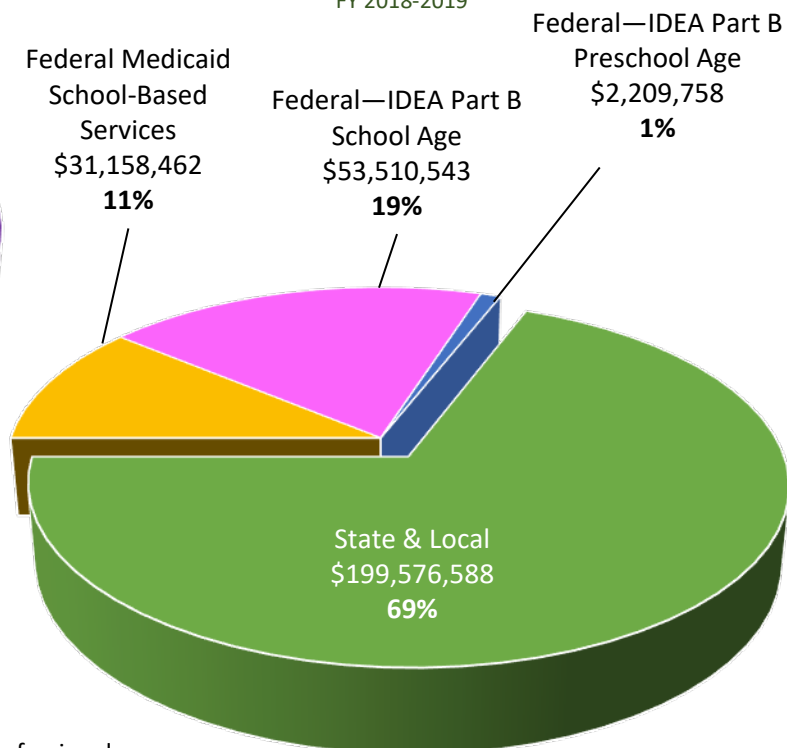

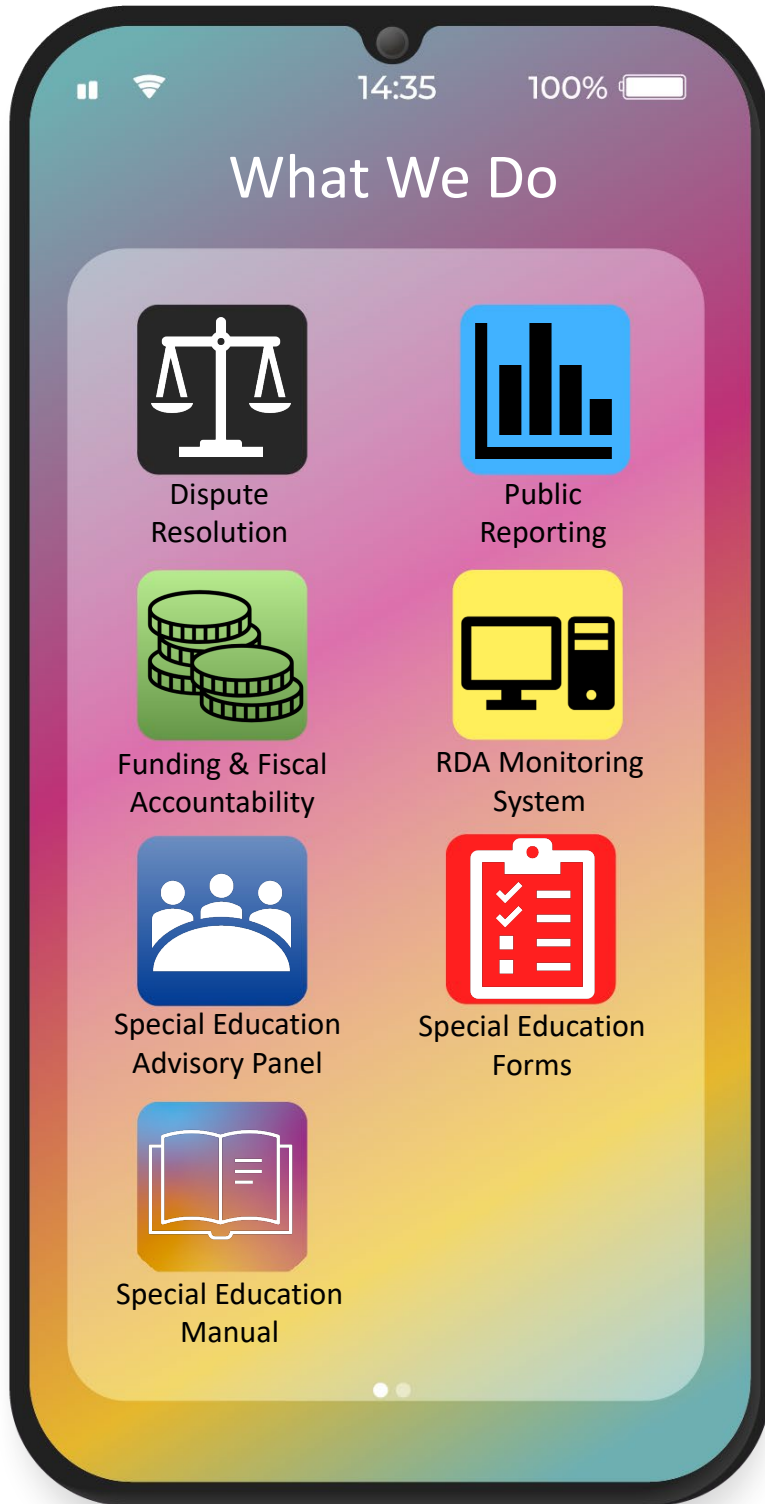

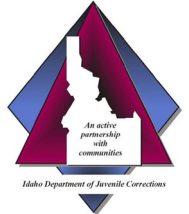
