As we begin the 2025–2026 school year, districts should be aware of an important change regarding the use of EDPlan for Section 504 Plans. **The EDPlan 504 Plan module is no longer being offered free of charge**. Districts that wish to continue utilizing EDPlan for 504 Plan management will need to contact EDPlan directly to inquire about pricing and implementation options.

Although EDPlan support will now require a paid subscription, the **Idaho Department of Education remains committed to providing free, high-quality resources** to assist districts in fulfilling their responsibilities under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.
